Commerce Control List Procedures & Practices

This course focuses on commodity classification using the U.S. Department of Commerce Control List (CCL) and its equivalent, the European Union List (EU List). Instructors will explain the list framework and how the 5 digit ECCN (Export Control Classification Number) relates to the International Control regimes and also provides national discretion. The ability to assign the correct ECCN is a fundamental skill for government experts to determine if an export license is required. Instructors will discuss the distinction between dual-use items, controlled under the Export Administration Regulation (EAR), and military items controlled under the International Trafficking in Arms Regulations (ITAR).

The course will feature a variety of teaching techniques to increase attentiveness and boost retention. Participants will learn the critical fundamentals, including:

- **Why** is this critical to your organization?
